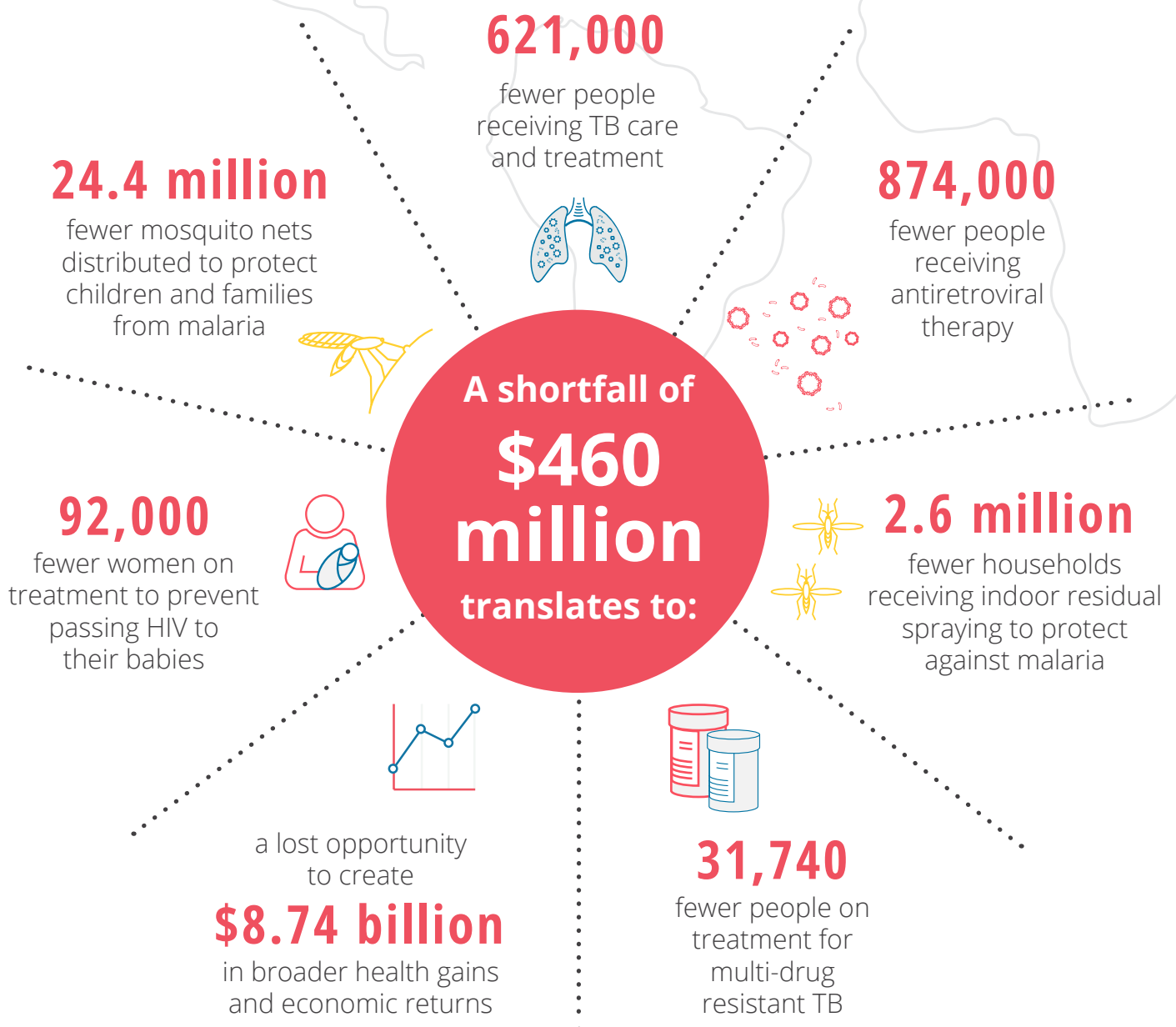


WHAT WOULD A \$460 MILLION BUDGET SHORTFALL DO?

Friends of the Global Fight urges Congress to fully fund the Global Fund with an appropriation of **at least \$1.56 billion in FY20**, but the President wants to slash the U.S. commitment to \$1.1 billion. Without adequate funding, we could see a significant resurgence of disease and lost opportunities.



The Global Fund contributes to achieving these results alongside sustained levels of other external funding, scaled-up domestic financing and more innovation, collaboration and rigorous execution.
