Friends urges Congress to appropriate \$1.533 billion to the Global Fund in fiscal year 2027.
This investment would translate to:

1.9 million



lives saved through programs supported by the Global Fund, and;

34 million



new infections or cases averted across HIV, TB and malaria, and;

\$27.5 billion



in economic returns through health gains, and;

2.4 million



people on life-saving antiretroviral therapy for HIV, and;

197,000 mothers



receive medicine to prevent transmitting HIV to their babies, and;

147 million



people receive HIV counselling and testing and;

2.1 million



people receive TB treatment and care, and;

47 million



people screened for TB, and;

55,000 people



receive treatment for multidrug-resistant TB, and;

83,000



HIV-positive TB patients receive antiretroviral therapy, and;

169 million



mosquito nets distributed to protect children and families from malaria, and;

48 million



children and families receive seasonal malaria chemoprevention treatments, and;

44 million



people receive malaria treatment and care

Estimates are derived from the modelling conducted to estimate the impact of the Global Fund 2026-2028 investment case. The Global Fund supports a range of interventions recommended by technical partners, which go beyond those presented in the results of this calculator. The results reflect contributions of Global Fund investments to national programs and their results.
